The lease was coordinated through Tom Nikolai of Mark Fornes Realty, Inc. According to Tom, "The deal is another example of the desirability of the Austin Interchange area. Hooven-Dayton will take occupancy December 1st and will immediately begin to move equipment, raw materials and people. Our objective is to seamlessly provide our high level of quality and responsiveness to all our customers during our move."
